



**Call for two Research Fellowships within the scope of the Project
"Educação pela Integração: o sistema escolar português na perspetiva da
integração de crianças e jovens imigrantes NPT residentes em Portugal e
requerentes de asilo"/ "Education for Integration: the Portuguese school
system in the perspective of non-native children and young immigrants and
asylum seekers in Portugal"**

Reference PT/2021/FAMI/713

An application for two Research Fellowships, within the scope of the Project "Educação pela Integração: o sistema escolar português na perspetiva da integração de crianças e jovens imigrantes NPT residentes em Portugal e requerentes de asilo" (reference PT/2021/FAMI/713) is open. These fellowships are funded by FAMI – Fundo para o Asilo, a Migração e a Integração/European Union and co-funded by the Portuguese State Budget, under the following terms:

1. Scientific domain: Education

2. Admission requirements:

- Master's degree in Education, Languages or related areas;
- Currently enrolled in a PhD programme.

3. Preferential requirements:

- Good communication skills and proficiency in Portuguese and English (namely speaking and writing skills);
- Knowledge and experience in quantitative data analysis;
- Knowledge and experience in qualitative data analysis.

4. Work plan: The fellowships shall support the Project *Educação pela Integração* (Education for Integration), which includes the following activities:

- Collecting and analysing documental and normative data;
- Systematic literature revision;
- Applying interviews, focus groups and questionnaires;
- Transcribing, analysing and processing the qualitative and quantitative data collected;
- Participating in the observation of activities in educational contexts;
- Supporting other tasks in the project development (memos and reports, seminars and workshops, etc.)

5. Applicable Legislation and regulations: Research Fellowship Statute, approved by Law No. 40/2004, of August 18th, in its current wording; Regulation for Research Grants of the Universidade de Lisboa, published in annex to Order no. 6238/2020, DR 2nd Series, no. 113, of 12th June 2020; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in effect.

6. Workplace: The work plan will be carried out at the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa (IE-ULisboa), under the scientific guidance of Otilia Sousa, Main Coordinator Professor of ESE-IPLx and Integrated PhD Member of the Research & Development Center on Education and Training (acronym UIDEF), as well as Maria João Mogarro, Associate Professor of IE-ULisboa.

7. Duration and regime of the fellowships: The fellowships will have a length of 6 months, with a predicted start in December 2021. The fellowships may be renewed for a total of 12 months.

The tasks as a fellowship holder are carried out under an exclusive dedication regime.

8. Value of the Monthly Maintenance Allowance: The fellowship holder receives a Monthly Maintenance Subsidy (MMS) in the amount of 1 104,64€ (one thousand, one hundred and four euros and sixty four cents), according to the table of stipends of the fellowships awarded by FCT I.P. (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>)

The fellowship holders will benefit from a personal accident insurance and, in case these are not covered by any social protection system, they can appeal to social security under the voluntary social insurance scheme according to the terms specified in no.1 of Article 22 of the Regulation for Research Grants of the Universidade de Lisboa.

9. Fellowship component payments: The payments owed to the fellowship holders will be made through a bank transfer to the account provided by the holder or check.

10. Selection and Valuation Criteria: The selection methods used will be based on the following parameters:

A – Master’s degree final grade (25%);

B – Experience in tasks mentioned in the work plan (25%);

C – Evaluation of the candidate’s profile, according to the project goals. Motivation, knowledge and availability will all be taken into account (50%).

The following percentage formula will be applied:

$$0,25 \times A + 0,25 \times B + 0,50 \times C.$$

The selection criteria will be evaluated on a scale of 0 to 20.

If deemed necessary, the three candidates with the best score may be called for an interview, which may be done by videoconference.

The interview grade will obey to the following criteria:

- a) Motivation for scientific research in general (25%);
- b) Motivation for researching in this specific area (25%);
- c) Knowledge in the specific area (25%);
- d) Critical analytical and thinking skills (25%).

11. Composition of the Selection Jury: The Jury was appointed by Order No. 39 of the Director of the Instituto de Educação of the Universidade de Lisboa, of 11th November 2021, and is constituted by:

- Doutora Otília Sousa, Main Coordinator Professor for ESE-IPLx, Integrated PhD Member for UIDEF, President of the Juri
- Doutora Maria João Mogarro, Associated Professor for IE-ULisboa, Member
- Doutora Maria João Hortas, Adjunct Professor for ESE-IPLx, Investigator for IGOT, Member
- Doutora Ana Sofia Pinho, Assistant Professor for IE-ULisboa, Substitute Member
- Doctor Teresa Costa Pereira, Elementary School Teacher, Ministry of Education, UIDEF Collaborator, Substitute Member

12. Results publication/notification: The final results will be published in a ranked list of final grades, in a visible, public location at the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa, and published on the website www.ie.ulisboa.pt. The approved candidates will be notified by email.

13. Application deadline: The application period will be open from **November 15th to November 26th** 2021.

14. Application presentation: The following documents are required to apply for the fellowship:

- a) Application form, available in www.ie.ulisboa.pt
- b) Copy of the identification document (declaration of consent available in www.ie.ulisboa.pt)
- c) Detailed Curriculum Vitae
- d) Proof of enrolment for the academic year in a doctoral course
- e) Certificates of qualification ^{1, 2}
- f) Motivation letter, recommendation letter(s) and other documents the candidates may deem relevant.

Remark 1: The documents proving the completion of academic degrees or diplomas, or registration in a study cycle leading to the academic degree, may be dispensed with during the application stage, being replaced by a declaration of honour by the candidates. However, the verification of those documents will be mandatory if the fellowship is obtained.

Remark 2: The academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require recognition by a Portuguese Institution according to Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16th, and Decree no. 33/2019, of January 25th. The presentation of such degree recognition is mandatory to sign the contract. More information can be found here: <https://www.dges.gov.pt/pt/pagina/reconhecimento?plid=374>. Under regular terms, if the recognition documents are not presented three months after the disclosure of the fellowship approval, the fellowship will not be granted.

15. Deadlines and procedures for complaints and appeals: If the decision is not favourable for the candidates, they have 10 days, starting from the date the results are disclosed, to make a statement in a prior hearing, under the terms of the Administrative Procedure Code.

The final decision may be appealed against to the Head of Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa up to 15 days after notification.
